

expectations for DISTANCE LEARNING

- 1. Cell phones turned off and out of sight.
- 2. Students should be attending virtual classes in a location conducive to learning.
- 3. Students are NOT permitted to share codes/work with others.
- 4. Students must follow all directives given by teachers during every class.
- 5. No music or audio should be played in the background during any class meeting time.
- 6. Behavior considered to be distracting to class meetings and/or other students, or not following the directives for virtual classroom management by their teachers, can lead to students being written up for the classroom disruption or insubordination.
- 7. Please advise all the adults in your home that your child is learning live and they should use appropriate language.
- 8. Please remind all the adults in your home that remote learning is taking place therefore they should always be dressed appropriately.
- 9. Adults must refrain from asking questions during the lesson. Any questions, parents may email the teacher once the remote live session is over.

student EXPECTATIONS

- Students are responsible for the completion of all daily lessons.
- Dedicate appropriate time to learning daily.
- Attend all live classes.
- Follow the school's dress code when attending live sessions.
- Do NOT eat during live Zoom sessions.
- Ensure you know usernames and passwords for instructional resources.
- Submit all assignments/ homework by due dates established by your teachers.
- Do your own work.
- Students must have an SMA background provided in Zoom in all classes while in eLearning Zoom sessions.
- Communicate with your teacher if you have questions or concerns. Ask for help if you need it.
- Be considerate of others when participating in online discussions.
- Follow the ADOM and St. Michael the Archangel Acceptable Use Police and be exceptional digital citizens.

parent EXPECTATIONS

- Communicate regularly with teachers and school staff through email.
- Ensure student is actively engaged and learning while attending live sessions.
- Create a learning space and daily routine.
- Regularly check parent portal.
- Participate in meetings required by the school or teachers.
- Support the community and prayer life of the school.
- Adhere to the school's absence policies, refer to the Parent/Student Handbook.
- Follow school policies for class assignments, homework, projects, tests and quizzes as well as academic integrity.
- Presume the best of the teachers and school leaders.
- Be sure your child eats breakfast and other meals.
- Be sure your child gets exercise daily.

virtual CLASS RULES

Do

- Create a quite place in your house to Zoom daily.
- Keep yourself on MUTE until it is your turn to speak.
- Be on time!
- Make sure siblings and/or pets know not to interrupt during this time.
- Complete uniform
- PE uniform on PE days

Don't

- Don't walk around with your device.
 Make sure to stay in one spot and sit during our meetings.
- Don't interrupt your friend when he/ she is talking
- **Don't** eat or drink during our Zoom meeting.

policies for BEHAVIOR

If student is not following Zoom rules or directions, he/she will be placed in the waiting room for 5 minutes. A second chance will be given. If behavior continues, a meeting will be requested with the parents and principal.

attendance procedures

- Attendance will be taken daily through Moby Max and in each CLASS (including special areas).
- If they miss one class they are ABSENT for the DAY.
- We know things happen and you all work so please make sure you download Zoom in all electronics (cellphone, tablet, laptop, desktop).
- If child is sick, please forward us a doctor note.

getting to MEET ON ZOOM

- We will be on Zoom from 8:00am to 12:00pm.
- We will be giving needed breaks in between our "Work Assigned" time. During this time students will be doing the assignments requested and we will be available for any assistance.
- Students face must always be seen during our Zoom meetings.

use of TECHNOLOGY

- During our meetings students need to be visible at all time.
- An iPad and a laptop work different for each program.
- List of usernames and passwords will be sent via email.
- Devices needed to be charged the night before.

all about HOMEWORK

- Work will be given each day. You will be provided with an assignment sheet each week.
- Students are expected to complete assignments within due date given.
- They will have time and questions answered during our "Work Assigned" time
- Any late work will decline in grade.

all about TESTS

- All tests and quizzes will be assigned on either their curriculum website or PlusPortals.
- Test will be given at a set time and your child needs to be seen while taking the test.
- Please make sure your child has the printout of usernames and passwords that we will provide for you so they can access all platforms independently.

creating A WORKSPACE


